Dear Parents/Guardian,

Information for Parents of Primary 2

On behalf of all my level teachers, I welcome your child back to school. I hope you had a splendid time bonding with your child/ward during the holidays.

To induct your child/ward into the new academic year, the first few days of school is dedicated to reconnect with your child/ward. The first two days will also be set aside to establish routines, such as, creating class rules and revisiting the school values.

I will also be speaking to the pupils on our level vision, key focus and behavioural norms. The teachers and I will be speaking about this very often and reminding them of these values and behaviour so as to get our Jieminites to be more ready and engaged in their learning. I am sharing this information with you so that you can speak with your child/ward on this at home and help us reinforce some of these values and good behaviour.

Snack Time	<p>11.30 a.m. to 11.35 a.m.</p> <p>Pupils are allowed to consume dry finger food in the classroom. We would like to encourage you to pack a healthy snack for your child, such as a bun, biscuits or nuts.</p> <p>Please note that Wednesdays are dedicated as 'Fruits Day'. You may want to pack fruits, such as an apple or a banana for your child. Alternatively, your child may purchase some snacks from the canteen during recess.</p>
Attire	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils must wear prescribed school uniform with name tag. • Primary 2 pupils are allowed to be in PE attire the whole day on PE and PAL days. • ONLY dark blue and black hair accessories are allowed (ONLY girls). <p>For more information, please refer to Jieminite's Handbook page 9.</p>

Medical Leave	When your child/ward is unable to attend school, he/she is required to produce a medical certificate the next day when he/she returns to school.	
Homework	The school has a homework policy and the teachers will provide a reasonable timeline for your child/ward to complete his/her work. Please lend us your support by checking your child's/ward's handbook and reminding him/her to complete his homework and submit it to the teacher on time.
