Dear Parents/Guardians,



Information for Parents of Primary 5 pupils

On behalf of all my level teachers, I welcome your child to the school. I hope you have had a splendid time bonding with your child/ward during the holidays.

To induct our children into the new academic year, the first two days of school are dedicated to connecting with them. These two days will also be set aside to ease our children into the school environment and establish routines like creating class rules and understanding the school values.

I will also be speaking to our children on our level vision and behavioural norms. The teachers and I will be speaking about this very often and reminding them of these values and behaviour so as to get our children to be ready and engaged in their learning. I am sharing this information with you so that you can speak with your child about this at home and help us reinforce some of these values and good behaviour.

In addition, I would also like to provide you with some other important information so that you can better support our children in their learning this year.

Reporting Time	7.30 a.m. to be seated in the hall
Recess Time	10.15 a.m. to 10.45 a.m.
Snack Time	12.10 p.m. to 12.15 p.m. Pupils are allowed to consume dry finger food in the classroom. We would like to encourage you to pack a healthy snack for your child, such as a bun, biscuits or nuts. Please note that Wednesdays are designated as 'Fruits Day'. You may want to pack fruits, such as an apple or a banana for your child. Alternatively, your child may purchase some snacks from the canteen during recess.
Attire:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pupils must wear the prescribed school uniform with a name tag.• ONLY dark blue and black hair accessories are allowed for girls. For more information, please refer to our Jieminite's Handbook, page 9.

Medical Leave:	When your child/ward is unable to attend school, he/she is required to produce a medical certificate the next day when he/she returns to school.
Homework:	The school has a homework policy and the teachers will provide a reasonable time-line for our children to complete their work. Please lend us your support by checking their homework and reminding them to complete the homework and submit it to the teacher on time.
Pupil Handbook:	<p>Every one of our children has a Jieminite's Handbook. They can make use of this Handbook to set targets for their learning or record notes. The Handbook is also used to write down homework to be completed. This Handbook may be used by class teachers to communicate with you whenever the need arises.</p> <p>Please help us by writing your contact details on the first page of the Handbook.</p>

Please assist in guiding our children to pack their school bag and ensuring that they bring the required books and materials to school every day. • An English storybook on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. • A Mother Tongue storybook on Thursdays and Fridays.

Attendance is compulsory for all pupils. More details will be given to you at a later date. - For pupils taking Higher Mother Tongue, they are required to attend lessons on a weekly basis on the following days starting from Term 1 week 2. Higher Chinese Language - Tuesdays 2.15-3.15 pm Higher Tamil Language - Mondays 2.15-3.15pm


