### School Examination Matters for Year 2018

My staff and I have been reviewing how we can make learning more meaningful and engaging for our Jieminites. In the area of assessment, for our school, we adopt two kinds of assessment. Assessment for Learning and Assessment of Learning. One of the key objectives of assessment is to provide feedback to improve students' learning. Assessment for Learning allows teachers to check for understanding and provide Jieminites with timely feedback consistently rather than at the end of term. Jieminites will then be able to better comprehend the expected learning outcomes and use the feedback to monitor their own learning.

Starting next year, we will be changing the weightage of our assessments so as to better align to the approach of Assessment for Learning and to give our pupils more time and space to explore their interests and passion in Semester 1. Thus, there will be no formal assessment in Term 1 for the Primary 1 to Primary 5 pupils. We believe that this new approach will help enhance our pupils' intrinsic motivation to do better and will drive them forward to greater explore and discover their interests and passions. Hence, nurturing the joy of learning in our pupils.


The breakdown in weightage is shown below:
